St Joseph's Year began on 8 Dec. 2020, and will end on 8 Dec. 2021. Pope Francis noted that this year marks the 150th anniversary of the Saint's proclamation as Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX on 8 Dec. 1870. The gospel of Matthew shows us that Joseph represents a central point in God's plan of salvation, even though he appears discreet and apparently on the margins of the story and of society. "Joseph lives his agency without ever seeking to take over the scene," he said. Everyone, he added, can find in St. Joseph—who often goes unnoticed or hidden—an intercessor and a guide in difficult moments. "He reminds us that all those who are

seemingly hidden or in the 'second

row' have unparalleled agency in the

history of salvation," said the Pope.

"The world needs these men and

women." Pope Francis noted that St.

Joseph offers our "fluid" modern

society a model of how to treat human

relations. He added that his thoughts

go out to all those who struggle

to find meaningful relationships in their own lives, saving this situation leaves many people feeling alone and lacking the strength to strive ahead.
